# The Tudor Trust

The Tudor Trust is an independent grant-making charitable trust which supports organisations working in any part of the UK. We support work which tries to meet the many different needs of people at the margins of society, and are interested in how organisations tackle these needs, and their root causes.

We don't have specific funding programmes designed to advance a particular agenda as we think that the groups we support are better placed to identify problems and develop solutions. Instead we aim to support a wide range of people and organisations working to build stronger communities.

Tudor's focus is on smaller, forward-looking groups, led by capable and committed people. We don't have fixed funding priorities but are looking for some key characteristics in the groups we fund. These include:

- Organisations working directly with people who are at the margins of society
- A focus on building stronger communities by overcoming isolation and fragmentation and encouraging inclusion, connection and integration
- Organisations which are embedded in and have developed out of their community – whether the local area or a 'community of interest'
- High levels of user involvement, and an emphasis on self-help where this is appropriate
- Work which addresses complex and multi-stranded problems in unusual or imaginative ways
- Organisations which are thoughtful in their use of resources and which foster community resilience in the face of environmental, economic or social change

We are more likely to fund groups with an annual turnover of less than £1 million.

This grants list details the grants made by the Tudor Trust between April 2010 and March 2011.

# Tudor's grant making in 2010-2011

Although we make grants to organisations our ultimate beneficiaries are of course the thousands of individuals that these groups work with and support, rather than the groups themselves. Over the year Tudor funded work across the UK which addressed the Trust's overarching aim of tackling the social, emotional and financial needs of people on the margins of society in many different ways.

Tudor doesn't have set funding priorities: our funding guidelines are broad because we want to support the work that groups really want to do by providing some of the resources they need to achieve their aims. This means that the grants we made over the year supported a diverse assortment of organisations and work: from a group working on conflict resolution and gang involvement with young people in Bristol to a new time bank working across two villages in rural Northern Ireland; from a group supporting young men who self harm in Lancaster to an organisation working to pilot a service for carers within refugee and asylum seeker communities in Redbridge.

The last few years have been extremely challenging for the voluntary and community sector. 2011 saw new levels of difficulty as the reality of central and local government funding cuts finally hit home. However, the trustees continue to be inspired by the energy, resolve and enthusiasm the groups we support display, even in the most difficult of circumstances. We look forward to working with many more excellent organisations in 2012.
